CLÁUSULAS INFORMATIVAS SOBRE PROTECCIÓN DE DATOS

Bilbao Exhibition Centre, S.A. (with registered address in Ronda de Azkue 1, 48902 Ansio-Barakaldo - 'BEC') and AFM (with registered address in Rue Saint-Lambert 135, Brussels, Belgium) are co-responsible for the processing of your personal data, as co-organisers of BeDIGITAL. For these effects, they are committed to collaborate in good faith to guarantee compliance with the obligations established in the field of data protection and, more specifically, to fulfil the exercise of your rights in compliance with the conditions established in this policy. The purposes of the processing of your data by BEC and AFM are (i) managing your participation in the fair and the contractual relationship that is generated as a result of your participation as an exhibitor in BeDIGITAL, and (ii) keeping you informed of future events related to the sector that may be of interest to you. The personal data provided will be held by BEC and AFM until the termination of the legal relationship that resulted of your participation in BeDIGITAL, or, where appropriate, until you exercise your right of opposition to the purpose (ii). As of this time, BEC and AFM may store your data, even blocked data, for a period of six years or for the limitation period of actions related to its responsibilities, when this period is in excess of the aforementioned.
